Appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act
made in the fifth Year of the reign of King George the fourth
intituled an act to provide for the establishing of Compositions
for ~~the~~ Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes growing
arising, yielded or payable within the Parish of Rathgraff
in the County of Westmeath. do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Two hundred and three Pounds one
Shilling and six pence halppenny ~~of~~ of which sum of
Two hundred and three Pounds one Shilling six pence
halppenny five ninth parts being One hundred and twelve
Pounds sixteen Shillings and four pence are due and
payable to the Reverend Chauvath Braine as a
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar
of the said Parish — and the remaining nine ninth parts
being Ninety Pounds five Shillings and three halppence
are due and payable to the Most Noble the Marquiss of
Westmeath as lay Proprietor of the said Parish — and
we do further certify that the average price of Oats being
the Grain principally grown in said County for the period
of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821
is fifteen Shillings and two pence halppenny per Barrel —
