

Take Notice, that on Thursday the Twenty
:ninth day of July one Thousand Eight hun:
:dred and Twenty four a Vestry was held at
the Parish Church of Rathkeale under the
late Tithe Composition Act of the fourth and
fifth of George the fourth when it was agreed
between the Rector and Parishioners of said
Parish that the sum of Seven hundred and
Eleven Pounds Sterling should be the Composition
for the Tithe of the aforesaid Parish to be paid
Yearly and every Year to the Rector of the said
Parish for the Term of Twenty one Years
from the first day of May one Thousand
Eight hundred and Twenty four. and that
John Southwell Browne Esq^r was appointed a
Commissioner on the part and behalf of the
Parishioners and Mr. David Ferguson on the
part of the Rector. Dated this 31st day of July
1824. —
