Whereas due notice having been given by Francis W. Blackburne Thomas Seeman Blayney R. Balfour and H. George Ramadge owners of Land in the Parish of Rathkenny in the County of Meath charged with the payment of the sum of £3 and upwards each in respect of the rent charge in lieu of Composition for Tithes within the said Parish made by the Certificate of Anthony Blackburn and Henry Sillery dated 11th October 1825 that in pursuance of the Statutes in such Case made and provided the said Owners would apply to the Justices of the Peace at the Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the average price of oats for the seven years preceding such application enquired of and ascertained in order that the annual rent charge in lieu of tithes charged upon and payable out of the said Parish might be varied and increased or diminished
