Certify that the just and true amount of
Compositions for all Tithes whatever within
the said parish is £ 203. 4. 4 Sterling by
the year for which sum of £ 203. 4. 4 & 1/3rd part
is due & payable to the Vicar Choral in the
diocese of Ossory as a Composition for the tithes
claimable by them as owners of the Vicarial
Tithes of said parish & the 2/3rd part is due
and payable to The Dean & Chapter of the
Cathedral Church of St Canice in said diocese
as owners of the Prebendial Tithes of said
parish

And I do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the Corn from especially
grown within the said parish for the period
of seven years ending 1st Nov 1830 is
£ 1. 12. 0⁰ Sterling
