in the said diocese as a Composition for the
tithes claimable by them as Owners of the
Rectorial tithes of said parish -
And I do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the Corn principally
grown within the said County for the period of
seven years ending 31st Dec. 1830 is £1.12.0 1/2
