


Received in the Registry of the Diocese of Ossory this 31st
day of October 1833

I John Stephens a commissioner duly appointed and
sworn under and by virtue of an act passed
in the 2nd & 3rd Year of the reign of his present
Majesty King William the fourth entitled "An
act to amend three acts passed respectively in the
4th, 5th & in the 7th & 8th Years of the reign of
his late Majesty King George the fourth
providing for the establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions
permanent" to ascertain & fix a just & true
Composition for all tithes arising growing
yielded or payable out of the Parish of
Rathkillyan & County of Kilkenny do Certify
that the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever within the said parish
is £ 203 " 4 " 4^d sterling by the year one third
of which is due & payable to the Vicars Choral in
the diocese of Ossory as a Composition for the
Tithes claimable by them as owners of the vicarial
Tithes of the said parish & 2/3 part is payable
to the Dean & Chapter of Meane in said diocese
as a Composition of the Tithes claimable by them
as owners of the Rectorial Tithes of said parish.

And I do further Certify that the
average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
grown within the said County for the period of
Seven years ending 1st Nov. 1830 is £ 1. 12. 0^d
