I, *Ralph Westropp Beckett* Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn under, and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third year of *William the Fourth*, entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and 7th & 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty *King George the Fourth*, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all TITHES arising, growing, yielded or payable, within the Parish of

Rathmance in the County of *Wexford* do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is *one Hundred & thirty nine* Pounds *two* Shillings and *seven* Pence by the year, of which Sum of *one Hundred & thirty nine* Pounds *two* Shillings and *seven* Pence, ~~is~~ due and payable to the following persons, as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by ~~them~~, viz:—

Rev. & Trans. Donnellan Rectorial £ 139. 2. 11
and vicarial Tithes united

And I do further certify that the average price of *oats* being the Corn principally grown in such county, for the period of seven years, ending on the *1st* day of *November* 1830 ~~that~~ is £ *0. 12. 11 1/2* shillings per barrel. *as extracted from Dublin Gazette*
