Containing one thousand six hundred and six acres two roods,
Irish plantation measure, liable to tithe, the annual
Value of which is four thousand one hundred and thirty six
pounds seventeen shillings and two pence farthing, on
which valuation the tithe is apportioned at one shilling and
two pence halfpenny per pound, which produces two
hundred and fifty pounds, being the sum applied for
by the Incumbent, the Rev. John Hunt, and agreed to by the tithe
payors of said parish, assembled in special Vestry, on the 18th
day of September 1826, agreeable to the provisions of the Tithe Com-
position Act, passed in the fourth year of the reign of his present
