

I John Palmer Howard, having being
duly appointed and sworn Commissioner, under
and by virtue of an Act made in the 2nd and 3rd years
of the Reign of King William the 4th Chapter 119. in-
titled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively
in the 4th 5th 7th and 8th years of the Reign of His
late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the
establishing of Composition of Tithes in Ireland
and to make such Composition Permanent (16th August
1832) to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable
within the Parish of Rathmore in the County of
Carlow. Do hereby Certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within said Parish is Seventy three Pounds and
17 of a penny by the year, and that that sum
is due and payable to the Reverend John Whitley
as a Composition for all Tithes claimed by him
as Incumbent of the Parish.

And I do further Certify the Average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the period of the seven years
ending the 1st November 1830- is one Pound, twelve
Shillings and $\frac{1}{2}$ British per Barrel.
