

J. Archd. Norfolk, being duly appointed and Sworn,
Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act, made in the
2nd & 3rd Year of the Reign of King William the 4th Chap. 119,
entitled, an Act, to amend three Acts, passed respectively in
the 4, 5, 7, and 8th Year of the Reign of his late Majesty
King George the 4th, providing for the Establishment
of Compositions permanent, (16th of August 1833) to ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising, growing, yielding, or payable, within the Parish
of Moyagher in the County of Meath, do Certify that
the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever in said Parish is £ 43^{..} 19^{..} 4 by the Year and that
the said Sum of £ 43^{..} 19^{..} 4 is payable to the Rev. R. Noble
as a Composition for all Tithes claimed by him as Rector
of said Parish of Moyagher; And I do further Certify, that the
Average price of Wheat, being the Corn principally growing
in said County for the Period of 7 Years, ending the first day
of November 1830 is £ 1^{..} 12^{..} 0 per Barrel
