

I John A. Mansford being duly appointed & Sworn  
Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act, made  
in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year of the Reign of King William  
the 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 119 entitled an Act to Amend three  
Acts passed respectively in the 4. 5. 7 and 8<sup>th</sup> Year  
of the Reign of his Late Majesty King George the 4<sup>th</sup>  
providing for the Establishment of Compositions  
permanent (16<sup>th</sup> of August 1833) to ascertain and fix  
a true and just Composition for all tithes arising  
growing yielding or payable within the Parish of  
Moyagher in the County of Meath do Certify that  
the true and just Amt. of Composition for all tithes  
whatsoever in Said Parish is £ 5<sup>0</sup> 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> by the Year and  
that the Said Sum of £ 5<sup>0</sup> 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> is payable to the Rev.  
Robt. Noble as a Composition for all tithes claimed  
by him as Rector of Said Parish of Moyagher and  
I do further Certify that the Average Price of  
Wheat being the Corn principally growing in  
Said County for the Period of seven Years  
ending the first day of November 1830 is 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>  
s. 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> d.
