Chap 119 entitled an act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, 7th,

King George the 4th, providing for the establishment
of Composition permanent (16th of August 1833
to ascertain and fix a true and just Compo-
sition for all Tithes arising growing yielding
or payable within the parish of Rathmore
in the County of Dublin do Certify that the
true & just Amt. of Composition for all tithes
whatsoever in said Parish is One Hundred and
Sixteen pounds five Shillings & five pence
British Currency by the year and that the s^d
Sum of One Hundred & sixteen pounds five
Shillings and five pence is payable to the
Rev^d. Rob^t. Noble as a Composition for
all Tithes claimed by him as Rector of said
parish of Rathmore and I do further Certify that
the average Price of Wheat being the Corn principally
growing in said County for the Period of 7 Years ending
the first day of November 1830 is One pound twelve
Shillings & six pence p^r M^l
