the establishment of compositions of Tithes in Ireland  
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true  
and just composition for all Tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the parish of Rathmore  
in the County of Meath do hereby certify that the true  
and just amount of composition for all Tithes &  
whatevver within the said parish is two hundred  
pounds by the year. All of which sum of two  
hundred pounds by the year is due and payable  
to the Rector Robt Johnson as a composition for the  
Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said  
Parish &

And we do further certify that the average  
price of oats being the corn principally grown  
in said County for the period of seven years ending  
on the first day of November 1821 is fifteen shillings  
and two pence one farthing. This 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April  
1825
