

I John Glascoe Esq: am in me now  
a Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of  
an act made in the second and third year of the Reign of King William  
the Fourth intituled, "An act to amend three acts passed respectively in  
the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh & eighth years of the Reign of his  
late Majesty King George the Second, providing for the establishing of Compo-  
sitions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent": to  
ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising,  
growing, yielded, or payable within the parish of Rathmore  
in the County of Kildare.

Do hereby certify that the true  
and just Amount of Composition for all tithes, whatever, within the  
said parish, is One hundred and thirty six pounds nine shillings  
and five pence halffpenny by the year of which sum of three hundred  
and thirty six pounds nine shillings and four pence halffpennies the one  
of that portion whereof which arises out of the Townland of Rathmore and  
its Subdenominations and also one third part of that portion thereof  
which arises out of the Townland of Casterton and its Subdenominations  
amounting to two hundred & two pounds three shillings and one penny  
per acre and due and payable to the Revd Mr Fielding as a  
Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of the  
said parish and the remaining two thirds parts of that portion thereof  
which arises out of the said Townland of Casterton and its  
Subdenominations amounting to two hundred and twenty four pounds  
six shillings and three pence four farthings are due and payable to Mrs  
Eliza Coogan as Lesse of Lieutenant Colonel Lush's Allow the tithes  
of the Rectorial Tithes of that portion of the said parish in me.

And I do hereby certify that the average price of oats  
being the crop principally grown in such County for the period  
of seven years, ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November one thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty, is thirteen shillings and three pence  
three farthings per barrel.
