a Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made
in the Second and Third Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth,
intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts, passed respectively in the Fourth,
"Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of his late Majesty
"King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for
"Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," to ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or
payable within the Parish of Rathmore ----- in the County
of Kildare ----- Do hereby Certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish, is
Three hundred and thirty six pounds, nine shillings, and five pence halfpenny by the Year,
of which Sum of Three hundred and thirty six pounds nine shillings,
and five pence halfpenny the entire of that portion thereof which
arises out of the Townland of Rathmore and its Subdenominations,
and also one-third part of that portion thereof which
arises out of the Townland of Ladestown and its subdenominations
are due and payable to the Revenue Fielding Office as a
Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of
the said Parish and the remaining two-thirds parts of
that portion thereof which arises out of the Townland
of Ladestown and its subdenominations are due and
payable to W^{ms} Eliza Coogan as Lessee of Lieutenant
Colonel Luke Allen the owner of the rectory tithes of that
portion of the said Parish.

And I do hereby Certify that the average price of Oats
being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the period of Seven Years,
ending on the 1st day of November, 1830, is Thirteen Shillings a cwt.
Three pence three farthings - per Barrel.
