the fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the
Establishment of Compositions for tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain & fix a true
& just composition for all Vicarial tithes arising
growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
Rathrea in the County of Mayo, Do hereby
certify that a true and just composition for all
Vicarial tithes whatever within the said Parish
for the Twenty one years next ensuing is Eighty
Pounds British sterling by the year which said
sum of Eighty Pounds British $\text{£}80$ is due & payable
to the Reverend Joseph Verschoyle as Vicar of
said Parish of Rathrea as a composition for
the Tithe claimable by him as owner of the
Vicarial tithes of said Parish and we do further
certify that the average prices of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on
the 1st day of November 1821 is $15/2\frac{1}{4}$ £ barrel
dated at Kellalla this 25th day of April 1829 mine
