

2d & 3^d William 4th Chap 119.

I Doucke White, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third year of the reign of King William the Fourth, Chap 119, entitled - "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," - to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable, within the Parish of Rathronan, in the County of Limerick, and Diocese of Limerick, do hereby Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is One hundred and thirty three pounds Sterling by the year, and which sum of One hundred and thirty three pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Reverend George Vaughan L. M. A. as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish.

And I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat, Barley, and Oats, being the Corn principally grown in said County, for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty, are for Wheat, One pound ten Shillings and three pence half penny for barrel of twenty Stone - for Barley, fifteen Shillings and five pence for barrel of sixteen Stone, and for Oats, eleven Shillings and nine pence three farthings for barrel of fourteen Stone Given under my hand this eighteenth day of May One thousand eight hundred and thirty three.
