

2d 43<sup>d</sup> William 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 114.

I Bowdler White, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third year of the reign of King William the Fourth, Chap 114, entitled - "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Rathronan in the County of Limerick and Diocese of Limerick, do hereby Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is one hundred and thirtythree pounds Sterling by the year, and which sum of one hundred and thirty three pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Reverend George Baughan I. Maste, as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish.

And I do further Certify that the average prices of Wheat, Barley and Oats, being the Corn principally grown in said County, for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty - are for Wheat One pound ten Shillings and three pence half penny per barrel of twenty Stone - for Barley, fifteen Shillings and five pence per barrel of sixteen Stone, and for Oats, eleven Shillings and nine pence three farthings per barrel of fourteen Stone.
