



Certificate

I the Reverend John Wether, Incumbent of the Parish of Ray, County of Donegal, and Archdeacon of the Diocese of Raphoe in the County of Donegal, having received from John Andrews Esq. of Comber in the County of Down Agent and for the Most Noble Charles William Vane Marquis of Londonderry, who is seized in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Ballylawn, Ballyboe, Ardnadishen, Drean, Upper and Lower Veagh, and Gorheran, a Notice in the words and figures following, "I do hereby require to take notice that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 22^d and 23^d Years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the fourth entitled an Act to amend the Acts passed respectively in the 5th and in the 7th and 8th Years of the said King's Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent, I John Andrews of Comber in the County of Down, Agent and for the Most Noble the Marquis of Londonderry who is seized in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Ballylawn, Ballyboe, Ardnadishen, Drean, Upper and Lower Veagh and Gorheran, containing about eleven hundred and seventy four acres Cunningham measure, the bounds whereof are particularly described in a Map hereunto referred, situate in the Parish of Ray, Diocese of Raphoe, and County of Donegal, do hereby signify to you, by the authority given unto me, by and on behalf of the said Most Noble Charles William Vane, Marquis of Londonderry, his desire to agree for and undertake the payment of the Compositions for Tithes, lawfully payable for and in respect of the said lands as aforesaid, and I hereby require you to grant to the said Most Noble Charles William Vane, Marquis of Londonderry, or unto me

me on his behalf, a certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of the said Act, declaring the said Most Noble Charles William Vane Marquis of Londonderry entitled to the benefit of this notice and to perform the other matters on their part required by the said Act to be done.
