I the Reverend John Hickey, Incumbent of the Parish of Dymocke and Archdeacon of the Diocese of Raphoe in the County of Donegal, having received from John Anderson Esq. of Dublin in the County of Down, a grant to and for the most noble Charles William Duke Marquis of Londonderry who is seized in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Ballylawn, Ballynagran, Ardusdichen, Duan, Upper and Lower Sagar and Terhewan a notice in the words and figures following: "I am hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2^d and 3^d Years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the fourth, entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 1st, 5th and in the 9th and 10th Years of the reign of His late Majesty, King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Concessions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Concessions permanent" I John Anderson of Dublin in the County of Down, agent to and for the most noble the Marquis of Londonderry who is seized in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Ballylawn, Ballynagran, Ardusdichen, Duan, Upper and Lower Sagar and Terhewan, containing about Eleven hundred one acre, four acres or more, measured, the bounds whereof are particularly described by a map hereto annexed, situate in the Parish of Don Barony of Raphoe and County of Donegal, do hereby signify to You, by the authority given unto me, and on behalf of the said most noble Charles William Duke Marquis of Londonderry, his desire to agree for and to discharge the payment of the composition for tithes lawfully due, and in respect of the said lands as aforesaid, and therefore require You to grant to the said most noble Charles William Duke Marquis of Londonderry
