Sir

You are hereby required to take notice, that in
pursuance of an Act passed in the 2^d and 3^d Years of the
reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled An Act
to amend three Acts, passed respectively in the 5th, 15th and in
the 7th & 8th Years of the reign of his late Majesty King George
the 3^d providing for the re-establishing of composition of tithes
in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent &
William Stewart of Keshmoo chief landlord seized in fee
simple of all that and those the Lands of Montlink the
Moles and bounds thereof are as follows; that is to say
bounded on the North by Sallybrooke, South by Drummskil,
East by Galdanagh, & West by Sallyboghy situate in the
Parish of Raymohy and County of Donegal a being otherwise
entitled, according to the provisions of said Act, to agree for
and undertake the payment of tithes lawfully payable for
and in respect of the said Lands, do hereby signify to you
my desire to agree for, and undertake the payment of such
composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said lands,
and I hereby require you to grant me a certificate in writing
conformable to the provisions of the said Act, declaring me en-
titled to the benefit of this Act, and to perform the other
matters on your part required by the said Act, to be done
