I the Reverend John Usher D.D. Incumbent of the Parish of Ray
moghly having received from William Stewart Esq. Chief Landlord
seised in fee of all that and those the Lands of Mount Clark
exclusive of that part of it held from the Earl of Wicklow Chief Landlord
by James Marshall commonly known by the name of Sullybrooke a notice in the
words and Figures following.

Sir, You are hereby required to take Notice that in pursuance of an Act
passed in the 2^d & 3^d Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth
entitled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th and in
the 7th & 8th Years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth pro-
viding for the establishing of the Composition of Tithes in Ireland, and to make
such Composition permanent" I William Stewart of Merristown Chief Landlord
seised in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Mount Clark, the Mules and
bounds whereof are as follows, that is to say, bounded on the North by Ladybrook
South by Drumohill, East by Galdenaght & West by Sullybrooke situate in the
Parish of Raymoghly and County of Donegal, or being otherwise entitled accord-
ing to the Provisions of said Act, do agree for & undertake the payment
of Tithes lawfully payable for & in respect of the said Lands do hereby signify
to you my desire to agree for & undertake the payment of such Composition
as aforesaid, for & in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you
to grant me a certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of the said
Act, declaring me entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other
matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
