I William Stewart Chief Landlord seized in fee of all that and those the Lands of Mountclink exclusive of that part of it held from the Earl of Wicklow Chief Landlord by Mr. James Marshall commonly known by the name of Tullybrooke declare my full and unqualified acceptance of the aforesaid ^{Beneficial} ~~Notice~~ and by these presents do agree to and accept the same in pursuance of the said Act of Parliament passed in the 2^d and 3^d Years of the Reign of His present Majesty King William the Fourth, and referred to in my said Notice —

Sir -

You are hereby required to take Notice that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2^d and 3^d Years of the Reign of His Majesty King William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 17th 18th and in the 7th & 8th Years of the reign of His late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishing of Compositions of Tithes in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent, I William Stewart of Hornhead Chief Landlord seized in fee simple of all that and those the lands of Mountclink, the metes and bounds whereof are as follows, that is to say bounded on the North by Tullybrooke, South by Drummohel, East by Baldonagh & West by Tullybagley, situate in the Parish of Raymaghy and County of Donegal or being otherwise entitled according to the provisions of said Act, to agree for and undertake the payment of Tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said lands, do hereby signify to You my desire to agree for and undertake the payment of such composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said lands, and I hereby require You to grant me a certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of the said Act, declaring me entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on Your part required by the said Act to be done —
