I beg leave to give you notice pursuant to the provisions of the Statute made and passed in the second & third years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the fourth intituled "an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh & eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland & to make such compositions permanent"

That I am desirous to agree for & undertake as provided by the said act upon your performing the matters & things prescribed & enacted to be done & performed on your part the future payment of the tithes composition payable & payable out of the Townlands or parts of Townlands & Lands situate in the Parish of Ray alias Raymaghey within the Barony of Raphoe & County of Donegal as described in the Map or Plan Chart or ground plan enclosed on this notice just deducting thereout the 15 per Centum on the amount as provided by the said act And I hereby require you in pursuance of the provisions of the said act to grant to me with all convenient speed a certificate under your hand & Seal of the import required by the said act in order that I may execute under my hand & Seal the declaration of the import required by the said act in the manner therein described And I give you notice that I am the chief Landlord or Lessee in Fee Simple of the rent & reversion of the said lands or premises and that I am ready to give you any further information in relation thereto which you may require upon receiving any notice from you for the purpose
