To the Earl of Wicklow
 My Lord I hereby certify that I have received from your Lordship a Notice in writing respecting the tithes of a part of your lands and Estates in the Parish of Ray alias Raymaghey in the Diocese of Raphoe of which I am the ecclesiastical incumbent and of which notice the following is a copy

"Rev^d Sir: I beg leave to give you notice pursuant to the provision of the statute made and passed in the second and third years of the reign of his present Majesty King George William the fourth intituled "an act to amend the Act made respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of His late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent - That you do observe to give you notice and undertake as provided by the said Act upon your part concerning the matters & things prescribed and enacted by the said Act to be done and performed on your part the solemn payment of the tithes composition & annuity payable out of the Town lands or parts of Town lands & lands situate in the Parish of Ray alias Raymaghey within the Barony of Raphoe & County of Donegal as described in the Map or Plan Chart or plan enclosed on this notice first deducting thereout the 25th per centum on the amount as provided by the said Act and I hereby require you in pursuance of the provisions of the said Act to give to me within all convenient speed a certificate under your hand and Seal of the import required by the said Act in order that I may execute under my hand and Seal the declaration of the import required by the said Act in the manner therein directed. And I give you notice that I am the Chief Landlord or Lessee in fee simple of the rent & reversion of the said lands or premises and that I am ready to give you any further information in relation thereto which you may require upon receiving any notice from you for the purpose.
