

Certificate

I the Reverend John Usher D.D. Incumbent of the Parish of Raymoghry in the County of Donegal having received from Messrs David & Robert Kincaid of Ballyholly in the Parish of Raphoe and County of Donegal and who hold from the Reverend John Lesley a Farm in Woodhill in the above Parish of Raymoghry a notice in the words and figures following,

Sir, you are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2^d and 3^d years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent We David Kincaid and Robert Kincaid both of Ballyholly in the Parish of Raphoe and County of Donegal and who hold a Farm in Woodhill in the Parish of Ray and County of Donegal from the Reverend John Lesley all that and those that part of the lands of Woodhill now in Possession containing Twenty eight Acres and One Rood that is to say bounded on the East by Durable on the West by Manderoy on the North and South by Woodhill situated in the Parish of Ray and County of Donegal or being otherwise entitled according to the Provisions in the said Act to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of said lands do hereby signify to you our desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of such Composition aforesaid for and in respect of said lands whereby we require you to grant us a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions in the said Act declaring us entitled to the benefit of this notice and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done
