

Certificate

I the Reverend John Usher D.D. Incumbent of the Parish of
Raymoghry ^{in the County of Donegal} having received from M^r Robert Vincail of Ballyholly
in the Parish of Straphoe and County of Donegal holding a farm of
land under M^r John Marshall during the life of John Lecky, which
farm is part of the lands of Drumcairn in the Parish of Raymoghry
and County of Donegal, a notice in the words and figures following,

Sir, you are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance of an Act passed
in the 2^d and 3^d years of the reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth
entitled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th
and in the 7th and 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George
the Fourth providing for the establishing of compositions for tithes in
Ireland and to make such compositions permanent" M^r Robert Vincail
of Ballyholly in the Parish of Straphoe and County of Donegal do hold and has
at present in my possession a farm of land containing thirty one acres
or thereabouts be the same more or less under John Marshall during the life
of John Lecky which farm is part of the lands of Drumcairn situate and being in the
Parish of Ray and County of Donegal and is bounded on the north by the townland of
Drumoghe and on the south east and west by portions of the townland of Drumcairn
aforesaid or being however otherwise entitled according to the provisions of the said Act to
agree for and undertake the payment of the compositions for tithes lawfully payable for
and in respect of the said lands, do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and undertake
the payment of such composition as aforesaid for and in respect of the said lands, and I
hereby require you to grant me a certificate in writing conformable to the provisions of the
said Act, declaring me entitled to the benefit of this notice and to perform the other matters
on your part required by the said Act to be done.
