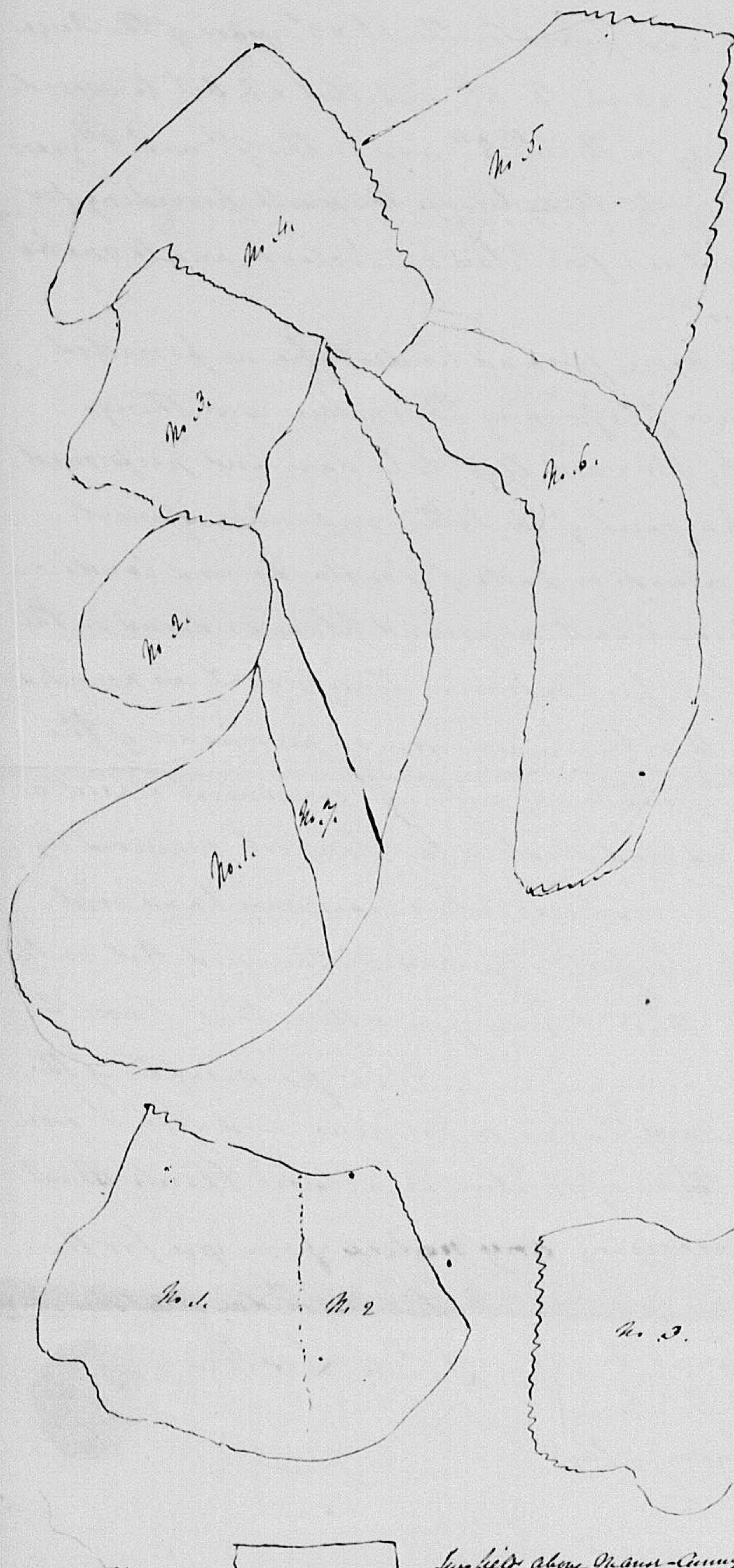


Map and Survey of several Townlands in the parish of
Raymothy, parts of the Estates of the Reverend John Leslie 1834

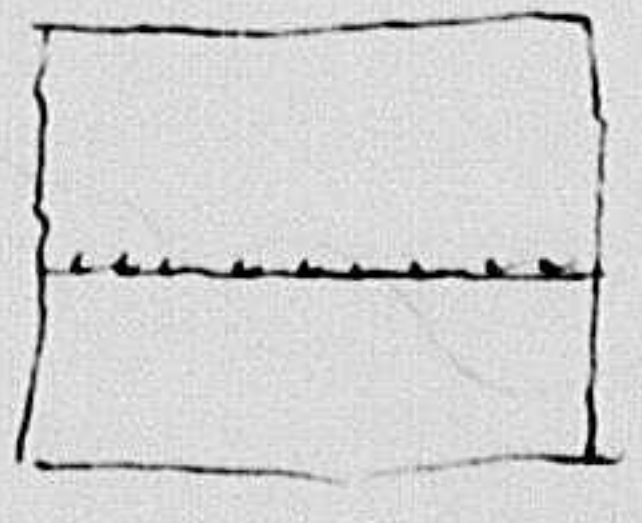
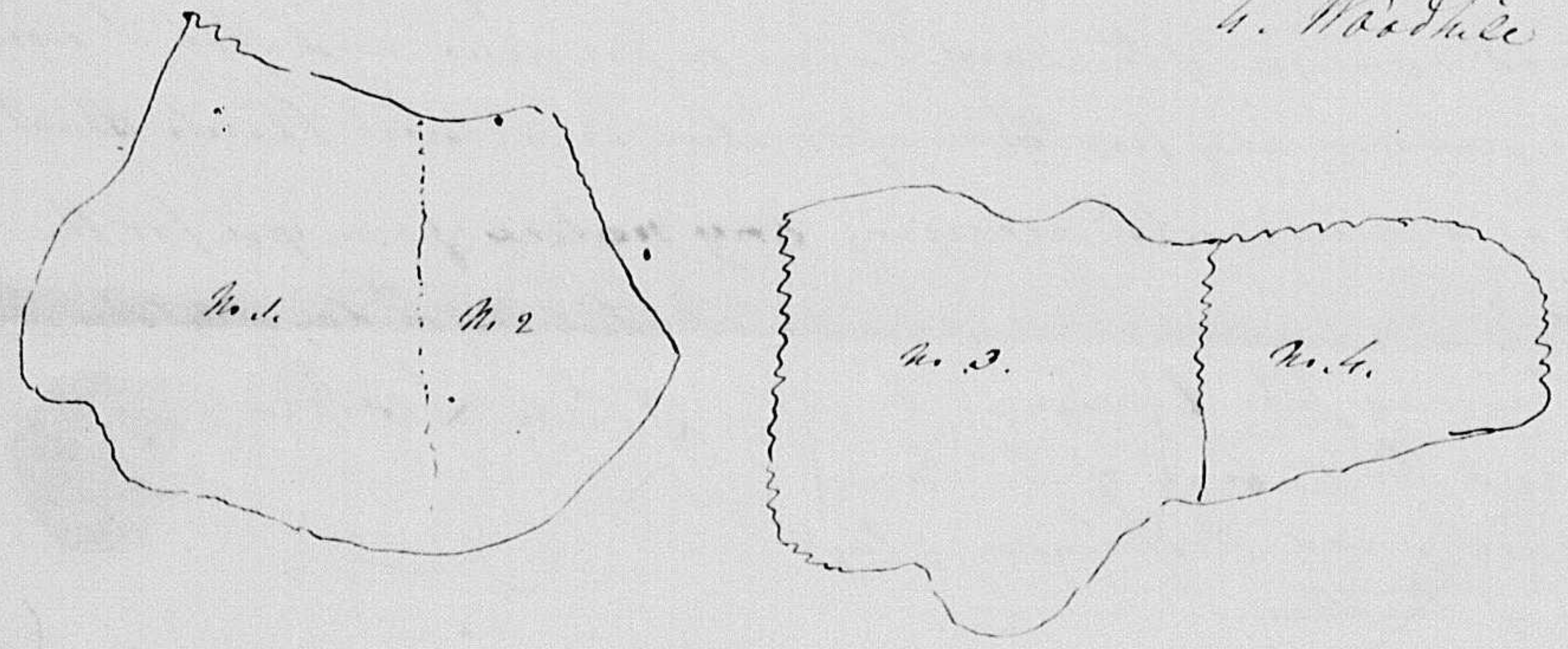

I hereby certify that I have received from you
a Notice in writing respecting the Tithing of the Townlands or parts
of Townlands and Lands of your Estates as described in the Map, Tom Chart
or Ground plan on the back of said Notice situated in the Parish of
Raymothy and Diocese of Raphoe of which I am Ecclesiastical Incumbent
and of which Notice the following is a Copy

Rev^d Sir I beg leave to give you Notice pursuant to the provisions of
the Statute made and passed in the 2^d 3^d years of the Reign of his
present Majesty King William the fourth entitled an Act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the 1st 5th and in the 7th and 8th Years of his late
Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent. That I am
desirous to agree for and undertake as provided by the said Act upon
your performing the matters and things presented and enacted by the
said Act to be done and performed on your part the future payment
of the Tithes Compositions payable and payable out of the Townlands or parts
of Townlands and Lands as described in the Map or Tom Chart or Ground
plan endorsed on this Notice first deducting thereout the 15 per Centum
on the amount as prescribed by the said Act, and I hereby require you
in pursuance of the provisions of said Act to grant me with all convenient
speed a Certificate under your Hand and Seal of the Import required
by the said Act, and in Order that I may execute under my Hand and
Seal the declaration of the Import required by the said Act in the manner
therein directed and I give you Notice that I am the Chief landlord
in fee simple of the Rent and Reversion of the said
lands and premises and that I am ready to give you any further information
in relation thereto which you may require upon receiving any Notice from
you for that purpose - Dated this tenth day of October 1834

and Archdeacon of the Diocese of Raphoe } signed John Leslie

And I now hereby declare that I consider you entitled to the benefit
of the said recited Notice according to the provisions of the said Acts
referred to on the fulfilment on your part of the Conditions specified in
