19-6¹/₂ being Two third parts are due and payable
to General Edward Dunne as a composition for
the Tithe claimable by him as Rectorial Incumbent
of said Parish and £ 79-9-9¹/₂ being One third
part is due and payable to the Rev. Thomas Pigott
the Vicar of said Parish

And we do further certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in
said County for the period of seven years ending on the
First Day of Nov^r 1821 is 15-2¹/₂ p^r Barrel
