sions of which I am the Head Landlord

East by the Lands of Lacknacavenagh, and Killma
on the south by Killmac Lakes and Downa Pias
and the Lands of Letterfrack, on the South West
by Ballinakil Bay, and the Lands of Downa, &c
This notice being under the 2^d and 3^d of William
the IV Chap 110 Sections 19. 20 & 21st
