You are hereby required to take notice, that in pursuance of an act passed in the second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled "An act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent," I, *Richard Monck of Banagher in the Kings County being appointed Trustee to William Mullock Esq; late of Banagher but now of Upper Canada North America and The New Alb. Bell L D of Cuba house in the Kings County and being in receipt of the Rents and the legal Estate of the said William Mullock* being vested in me

of all that and those, Part of the Lands of Banagher and the Lands of Gortagowen &c meted and bounded as follows viz
on the North by the high road leading to Parsonstown
Thomas Thompsons holding and the Street of Banagher
on the South by the little River of Lusmagh on the East by
the Glebe Lands of Britanni otherwise Leccarrow and on
the West by the Barrach Lands and the River Shannon
held by lease of lives renewable for ever containing in
