Shillings and nine pence farthing, British currency, of which
sum of four hundred and sixty one pounds, ten shillings and
nine pence farthing, the whole is due & payable to the
Reverend Thomas Graves, as a composition for the Tithe
claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish -
