

2nd and 3rd William the 4th Chap 119

I, John A. Waters, a Commissioner duly appointed and sworn in and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the reign of King William the fourth, Chap 119 entitled an Act to amend the Acts passed respectively in the fourth and fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent do ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Robinstown in the County of Limerick and Diocese of Limerick to hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for tithes whatsoever within the said parish is Three thousand and sixty seven pounds twelve shillings and ten pence half penny Sterling of which Sum of three thousand and sixty seven pounds twelve shillings and ten pence half penny Sterling the Sum of Two thousand and twenty one pounds eight shillings and seven pence Sterling is due and payable to William Drigan Esq^r the Lessee of the right Honourable the Earl of Cork and Erris for the tithes claimable by him as Lay Impropriator the Sum of one thousand and ten pounds fourteen shillings and three pence half penny Sterling is due and payable to the Rev^d James W^m Graus as Vicar of said parish and his Successors and the Sum of thirty five pounds ten shillings Sterling is due and payable to the Right Honourable the Earl of Cork and Erris out of the Townlands of Shimish and Trammore both of which Townlands appear to belong to the Parish of Robinstown and I do further Certify that the average prices of wheat and oats being the Corn Principle grown in said County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty are for wheat per Barrel of twenty Stone one pound twelve shillings and a half penny British and for oats per barrel of fourteen Stone twelve shillings and eleven pence half penny British
