Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to
make such Compositions permanent to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all - Tithes arising
growing & yielded on, payable within the Parish of
Robertstown in the County of Dunrick and Diocese of Dunrick
Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Three
Hundred and Sixty seven pounds Twelve Shillings and
Five pence Halfpenny Sterling of which sum of Three
Hundred and Sixty seven Pounds Twelve Shillings and
Five pence Halfpenny Sterling the sum of Two Hundred
and Twenty One Pounds Eight Shillings and Seven Pence
Sterling is due and payable to William Morgan Esq^r
the Agent of the Right Honourable the Earl of Cork and Antrim
for the Tithes claimable by him as day Proprietor the sum
of Two Hundred and Ten pounds Fourteen Shillings and
Three pence Halfpenny Sterling is due and payable to the
Reverend James Willard Esq^r Vicar of said Parish
and his Successors and the sum of Thirty five Pounds Ten
Shillings Sterling is due and payable to the Right Honourable
the Earl of Cork and Antrim out of the Townlands of Uhanish
and Tanamore both of which Townlands appear to belong
to the Parish of Robertstown and I do further Certify
that the Average prices of Wheat and Oats being the Com-
monly grown in said County for the Period of seven years
ending on the first Day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Thirty are for Wheat per Barrel of Twenty Stone One Pound
Twelve Shillings and a Halfpenny British and for Oats per
Barrel of Fourteen Stone Twelve Shilling and Eleven Pence
Halfpenny British.
