on 25th January 1890

Whereas the said James D.
Pratt, is the Lay Impropriator of
said Parish, and the person
receiving and entitled to receive
the Rent charge payable in
lieu of the composition for all
the Impropriate Tithes within
such Parish made ascertained
and fixed by the Certificate
bearing date the 11th December
1833 of Owen Thomas Lloyd the
Commissioner, duly appointed
in pursuance of the Statutes in
such case made and provided
by which Certificate the gross
amount of composition for
all Tithes whatever in said
Parish was, certified to be
the annual sum of £248.11.10
which sum was, certified to be
due and payable to John Pratt

Esquire the then Lay Impropri-
ator of said Parish each and
every year

And Whereas the said Robert
Baile, John B. Coulter, and
Sidney Jackson and John
Johnston, duly served notices
to be affixed and given at the
times and in the manner dir-
ected by the Statutes in such
case made and provided, and
made application to the Justices
of the Peace at the Quarter
Sessions held at Dundalk, in said
County on the 28th October 1889
to have the average price of wheat
being the grain or corn in said
Certificate mentioned for the
proceeding seven years in
pursuance of the Statutes in
that behalf inquired of and as-
certained in order that the
said composition for Tithes, and
the Tithes Rent charge in lieu
thereof might be varied and
diminished, according to such
average price as compared
