advised the matter of said
application to the present
Quarter Sessions

And Whereas the said app-
lication pursuant to said ad-
visement came on for further
hearing before the Justices at
the present Quarter Sessions
and the said applicants app^{er}
earing by Counsel and the
said Notices of application
and Certificate and the title
of the applicants and the
average price of wheat as
advertised in the Dublin
Gazette for the said period of
seven years having been proved
Now the said Justices do
ascertain from the Dublin
Gazette that the average
price of wheat for the said
period of seven years immed-

ately preceding the date
hereof is Eighteen shillings
and ten pence Sterling for each
Barrel of twenty stone and the
said Justices do accordingly
order and adjudge that the
amount of said composition
in said Parish for said Impu-
propriate Tithes and Rent charge
payable in lieu thereof shall
be diminished in proportion
to the difference between the said
average price of Eighteen shillings
and ten pence Sterling for the period
of seven years and the average
price of £1. 12. 0¹/₂ stated in the
Certificate of the composition
And the said Justices do further
order that the appointment of such
composition shall be amended and
diminished accordingly and that
said diminution shall take effect
from 1st day of May 1890
