Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and
by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of
the Reign of King George the fourth entitled an Act
to provide for the establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in England for a limited time to ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish
of Haddington in the Diocese and County of Meath
do hereby Certify that the true and just Amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the
Said Parish is One hundred and Twenty pounds
British by the year which sum of £120 British
is due and payable to the Rev. Tomson by
Houldsbury yearly as Rector of said Parish as a
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him.
And we do further Certify that the average price
of wheat being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the period of seven years ending
on the 1st of November 1724 is one pound Eighteen
Shillings and eight pence halypenny per Bann.
