Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and
by virtue of an act made in the Fourth Year of the reign
of King George the Fourth intituled an act to provide
for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for all Tythes arising, growing, yielded
or payable within the Parish of Gallottenion of
Raddenstown, in the County of Meath do hereby
Certify that the true and just amount of Com-
position for all Tythes whatever within the said
Parish is One hundred and Forty pounds, by the year
which sum of £140 is due and payable to the
Rev'd Lansley Goulding as a ^{just} Composition
for the tythe claimable by him as Rector of said
parish And we do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the period of Seven Years ending
on the first day of November 1821 is One pound
Eighteen Shillings and Eight pence halfpenny per
barrel - Dated this 1st day of February 1825
