Twenty one years from the 1st day of May 1826 & that such composition
shall continue to be levied for such term of 21 years, & shall not be
subject to any variation in the amount thereof during such period of
21 years under the provisions of the 1st of Geo IV Chap 99 & the 5th Geo IV Chap 63
