

The Stephen Wright and John Dwyer Commis-
sioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue
of an act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of
King George the fourth intituled "An act to provide
for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and
Just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing,
yielded, or payable within the Parish of Rosconell
in the Counties of Kilkenny and Queens County,
do hereby Certify, that the true and Just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is One Hundred and forty three Pounds, one
Shilling and six pence half penny British by the
Year, of which Sum of One Hundred and forty
three Pounds, one Shilling and six pence half
penny the Entire is due and payable to the Rev^d
Thos^r Kearney as a Composition for the Tithe
claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the
said Parish. And we do further Certify that
the average price of Wheat, being the Corn prin-
cipally grown in the County of Kilkenny, for the
period of seven years ending on the first day
of
