Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or
payable within the Parish of Rosmalis in the Queen's
County. I hereby certify that the true and just
amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Four hundred and thirty two pounds
sterling by the year of which sum of Four hundred and
thirty two pounds two third parts are due and payable
to General Edward Dunne as a Composition for the
Tithe claimable by him as Impropriate Rector of said
Parish and the One third part is due and payable
to the Rev^d Thomas Pigott the Vicar of said Parish
and We do further certify that the Average price of
Oats (being the Corn principally grown in such Com^{es})
for the period of seven years ending on the first day
of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty
three is fifteen shillings and two pence farthing per
bushel,
