You are hereby required to take notice, that in pursuance of an act passed in the second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled "An act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent," I, *William Edward Flood Sharp*

of *Moscully's* in the *Queen's County* being *Chief*
Landlord
