Composition for the Tithe Claimable by Him as Rector
& Vicar of said Parish. And we do further Certify that
the average Price of Oats being the Corn principally
Grown in such County for the Period of Seven years
ending on the First day of November 1821 One is Fifteen
Shillings and two pence half ^{penny} per Barrel. - Given under
our hands this 2^d day of Decemr 1826 Six
