

I Thomas Dohy Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an act made in the second and third year of the reign of his present Majesty King William the fourth. intituled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and seventh and eighth year of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for a composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such composition permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the parish of Cappinane in the County of Wicklow do certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and seven Pounds of which sum of Two Hundred and seven Pounds one third part or Sixty nine Pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Anthony Pack L.L.D. as composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish and two third part or One Hundred and thirty eight Pounds is due and payable to John Sutherland Esq. as Lay Proprietor of the Rectorial Tithes of the said Parish  
And I do further certify that the average price of <sup>wheat</sup> ~~corn~~ being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven <sup>and eleven and a half</sup> years ending November the 1<sup>st</sup> 1830. is thirty two shillings per Barrel
