

Agreement

It is hereby agreed upon by the Rev^d
James Lowry Dickson Vicar of the Parish
of Rosinver in the Diocese of Kilmore and
Counties of Leitrim and Sligo and by (Esq)
Terence Cunnolly Esq. on the part of Robt. Johnston
who holds ^{Vicar of said parish} under the Right Rev^d the Lord Bishop
of Kilmore, And by the aforesaid Terence
Cunnolly on the part of Owen Wynne Esq.
^{Proprietor} of said Parish and by Special
Vestry duly held for said Parish pursuant to
the provisions of the 2nd and 3rd William 4th
Chap 99 entitled an act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th and in
the 7th and 8th years of the reign of his
late Majesty King George 4th providing for
the establishing of compositions for Tithes in
Ireland and to make such compositions permanent

It is agreed upon by the parties aforesaid and the
Special Vestry that the sum of Four Hundred
and Fifty ^{pounds} (£450) shall be paid as ^{the} annual composition
under the said act for all the Tithes payable out
of said Parish of Rosinver in the following proportions
namely to the aforesaid Rev^d Jas^{ts} Lowry Dickson Vicar
£170 and to the aforesaid Terence Cunnolly on the part of
Robt. Johnston Esq. who holds under the Bishop £140
and T. Cunnolly Esq. on the part of Owen Wynne Esq. £140
