

We John Browning and John Pearson Commissioners
duly appointed, and sworn under and by virtue of
the several acts made in the fourth and fifth years
of the reign of King George the fourth. entitled an
act to provide for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time and
also an act to amend said last mentioned act
to ascertain and fix a just and true Composition
for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the Parish of Massamogon in the
County of Wexford do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish is one
hundred and seventy nine pounds by the
year as agreed on at vestry which sum of
one hundred and seventy nine pounds is
due and payable to the Rev. Major Owen as
parson as a Composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as Rector of said Parish the
said Composition to be in force for twenty
one years and not subject to variation
during that period.
