pounds by the year. Of which sum two hundred
pounds are due and payable to the Rev. James Keenan
the Vicar of said Parish, and one hundred and ninety
four pounds are due and payable to His Grace the
Duke of Devonshire as Lay Impropriator, being
the average of the sums agreed for and paid to His
Grace for the seven years successively preceeding the
1st of November 1830, increased by one fifth of the utmost
the act allows / the average of the said sums not
appearing to have been an adequate compensation
for the Tithe of the several articles in which such
sums have been paid and agreed for—

And I do further certify, that the average
price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in
this County for the period of seven years ending
on the 1st of November 1830 is twelve shillings and
eleven pence halfpenny per barrel
