permanent. To Ascertain and fix  
a true and just Composition for all  
Tithes Arising, Growing, Yielded, or  
Payable within the Parish of Kussah  
in the County of Westmeath.

do hereby Certify, that the true  
and just Amount of Composition  
for all Tithes whatever within the  
said Parish, is, Eighty Six pounds  
five Shillings <sup>6</sup>/<sub>d</sub>. By the year.  
Of which Sum, Thirty three pounds  
Fifteen Shillings, are due and
