

Certificate of Composition for all tithes in the  
Union of the Parishes of Saint Canice and Ballybun  
in the Diocese of Ossory

We John Wood of Sunnaton in the  
County of Wicklow and Joseph Longman of the City of  
Wicklow Esqrs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn  
under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth  
year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an  
act to provide for the establishment of Composition for  
tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and  
fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising  
growing, yielded or payable within the Union of the Parishes  
of Saint Canice and Ballybun in the Diocese of Ossory  
said County and County of the City of Wicklow do  
hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition  
for all tithes whatever within the said Parishes is  
four hundred and fifty pounds British by the year  
is due and payable to the Vicar Choral of the Cathedral  
of Saint Canice or their Successors as a Composition for  
the tithes claimable by them as vicars of the tithes  
of said Parishes

And we do further certify that the  
average price of wheat being the corn principally grown  
in the County and County of the City of Wicklow for  
the period of seven years ending the first day of  
November 1821 is one pound eighteen shillings and eight  
pence half penny <sup>& 3d</sup> late Irish currency
