Situate in the Parish of St. Stephens Barony of Dungfora and
County of Westmeath as the same are more particularly described
in a map or Tenchard or ground plan annexed hereto and
the same shall hereafter become due and payable to us
according to the provisions aforesaid. And further in Compliance
with the provisions of said Statute, I do hereby declare
the acceptance of your said agreement, and undertaking to
pay said Tithes, and that you are entitled to the benefit
thereof
